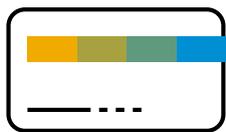
apetito UK's primary focus is food, but it is a business that is increasingly concerned with data. It makes 63,000 deliveries each year, with delivery drivers covering 12,000 routes per year. To optimise its services, apetito must analyse of a huge amount of data.

“We’re pushing digital across the business,” says Nick Swallow, Senior Project Systems

Accountant. “We have a new analytics team and a new DevOps team, and we see a real opportunity to use data to our benefit.”

The business wants to be more agile. To do this, it needs to be easier to spot financial trends so important decisions can be made faster. As part of this, apetito UK wanted to create a purchase-to-pay system, enabling individuals to make purchasing decisions efficiently, within company spending guidelines.

“We want employees to be doing their jobs, running the business, and not be slowed down by bureaucracy,” says Swallow. “If IT needs a new piece of hardware, or Marketing needs to launch a new campaign, they shouldn’t be slowed down by a 10-step procurement process.”

Efficient Procurement Processes Support Business Agility

apetito UK was already using Concur® Expense to improve its expense management process. Through a trusted partnership with SAP Concur, Concur® Invoice now also helps apetito UK to streamline purchase requests and automate invoice approvals. It identifies inaccurate and duplicate invoices before they are paid and establishes a simple two-stage approval process that doesn't slow the business down.

apetito UK has used Concur Invoice since August 2018. All employees have access to a Concur Invoice account, and there are 300 regular users. Swallow says the SAP Concur solution delivers the control, traceability, and agility they were looking for: "It allows teams to get on with their day jobs."

Employees can now make a request-to-purchase through their Concur Invoice account, with an approval request sent to their line manager. "The line manager can then approve, from anywhere, via a mobile device, with a full view of the purchase," Swallow explains. "They know the individuals involved, and how much they have to spend. It doesn't hold up the business."

This agility does not sacrifice control. Each department has clear monthly budgets, high-

cost invoices still need senior manager approval, and analysis of weekly and monthly spending helps to inform future budgets.

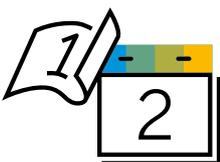
"This business is highly diligent at the month end," says Swallow. "We go into the figures in huge detail, and with Concur Invoice we have clarity around procurement."

Concur Invoice creates predefined reports and dashboards to provide a comprehensive view into spending for more informed decisions and better control over cash flow. "We can also tailor our own P2P trigger reports to understand where all invoices are in the payment process and can update relevant users and management."

In addition, it significantly reduces the time and resource spent on processing supplier invoices through an automated solution.

"This is a large organisation but with a family feel. What has been most encouraging is the way Concur Invoice has been adopted by employees," Swallow says. "Users can clearly see the benefit."
